
Men's Breakfast

School Improvement Plan

Each year HCS administration reevaluates our School Improvement Plan to address current needs. The 2025-2026 School Improvement Plan has three goals based upon the overarching needs of our students and faculty:

1. By the end of the 2025-26 school year, 85% of students will demonstrate growth, or learning gain, and be on grade level or above as measured by the Iowa Basics standardized tests core composite. 2. Enhance the rigor and relevance of curriculum to ensure that all students have access and entry points to high level content and skills. 3. By the end of the 2025-2026 school year, all HCS students will have received discipleship and opportunities to serve our community. Our teachers will also continue to work toward building the technological skills of our students.

Miss Fiero's third graders worked hard during the first semester and have started the second semester with the a hard-working attitude. In math, they have worked on their math facts by doing speed drills and using XtraMath on the computers in the classroom. For reading, they have worked on completing the reading homework each evening and answering a comprehension question with complete sentences as well as reading the book Stone Fox (about a young boy who tries to save his grandfather's farm by winning a dog sled race) and writing about it. In Bible class and to help them grow in their spiritual walk, they have had Sword Drill competitions, worked together on Missions Day serving HCS neighbors, and completed special coloring sheets to send in the Operation Christmas Child boxes. They have been doing test preparation using wayground.com as a study tool. Their penmanship is enhanced as they make journal entries. They recently worked on watercolor paintings of the Northern Lights in art. This project helped them experiment with color blending while appreciating God's marvelous creation.


2025-2026 AFTERCARE FEES:

3:30-4:00 p.m.: No Charge

4:00-5:00 p.m.: \$5.00 per family

After 5:00 p.m.: \$5.00 per child for every 5 minutes or part of a 5 minute increment

Aftercare accounts, like lunch accounts, are set up as prepay family accounts. Charges for each family for the entire week are billed out the following Tuesday or Wednesday. Payment may be made online through the Family Portal or in the school office.
